

### Financial Incentives

#### **Small-Scale Developers**

- Rates remissions
- Grants and subsidies
- Increase in property values

#### Medium and Large-Scale Developers

- Modifying the development contribution process
- Selling a strip of land
- Grants and subsidies
- Industry awards
- Increase in property values





Regulatory Incentives

#### **Small-Scale Developers**

- Extra titles
- Resource consent fees reduction
- Resource consent assistance
- Urban design advice

#### Medium and Large-Scale Developers

- Density incentives and additional height limits
- Auckland Council fast-tracking consents





Moral Incentives

#### **Small-Scale Developers**

- Underlying desire to act for the public good
- Would permit easements across their land

#### **Medium-Scale Developers**

• Desire to act for the public good to enhance an areas liveability

#### Large-Scale Developers

• Act for the public good to enhance their reputation







### Overview

- Developers very open to greenways
- Slight disconnect between case studies and interview results
- Likely that incentives could overcome greenway development barriers/frustrations
- Desire to cater for the public good
