Types of changes

- **Bug fix** – when a previously identified issue has been patched as part of a new release.
- **Data** – includes fixing a data error, adding new data such as layers.
- **Map tool** – patching a previously identified issue with a map tool.
- **Basemap** – update or change to an existing basemap or an addition.
- **Layer** – update, fix or change to an existing layer or an addition.
- **Symbol** – visual change to a layer's appearance.
- **New Feature** – new feature within a map or maps such as a tool or layout.
- **General** – all other fixes, updates or changes that aren't any of the above.

N/A	10/22	Bug fix	All	Enquiries	The "Send Enquiry" tool was not supporting adding drawings and selecting from layers.	This functionality has been restored.
SD-254	10/22	Bug fix	All	Drawing tool	A bug causing the drawing tool not to be able to draw from layers in the map as expected.	The drawing tool can now create drawing from layers within the layer list.
N/A	8/22	General	All	Branding	The New Zealand Walking Access Commission has changed it's name to Herenga ā Nuku Aotearoa the Outdoor Access Commission and has a new branding and style guide to support.	WAMS / Our Maps is now referred to "Herenga ā Nuku Maps" on the map gallery . The map gallery and viewers have now been rebranded to match Herenga ā Nuku's website and brand .
