Coming from Hamilton, Take SH3 (Ohaupo Road). Turn right on to Ngaroto Road and follow the road all the way until you come to a T-intersection with Paterangi Road. Turn right at this T-intersection and follow along Paterangi Road and then take Bank Road where Lake Ngaroto is found at the end of the road.
